

Berger Primary School

A new 2-storey building built in the grounds of the existing Berger Primary School in the London Borough of Hackney. The new addition includes a nursery, community rooms, staff facilities, a double-height dining hall and 15 classrooms. The curved panels follow the turn of the stair in the main circulation space. It has been awarded a BREEAM Excellent rating, the first primary school in London to secure this rating. With a score of 74.26% it was the 4th highest rating ever awarded on an education project, at the time of certification.

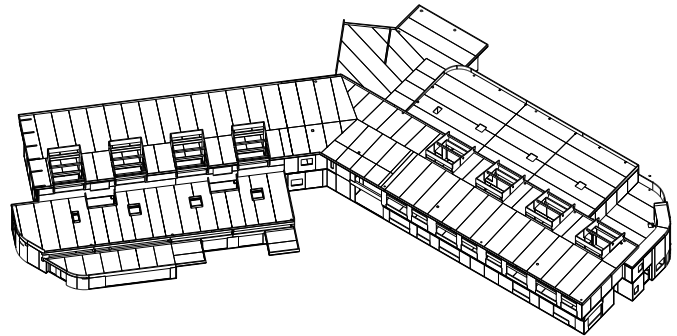
