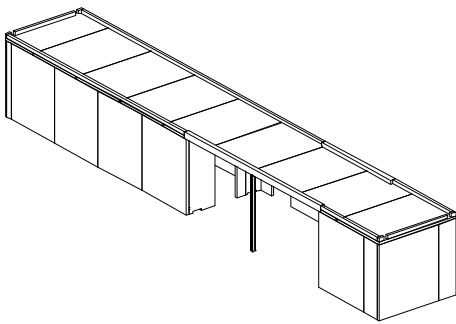


REGENTS PARK THEATRE



New back of house facilities to Regents Park Open Air Theatre. As part of the modernisation of the back of house facilities, new changing rooms, workshops as well as a new entrance and box office have been constructed using solid timber. The design of the building and the installation of the panels had to respect the position of several protected trees on the site. The building received a commendation in the Civic Trust Awards and won the New London Architecture Award for Public Buildings.
